

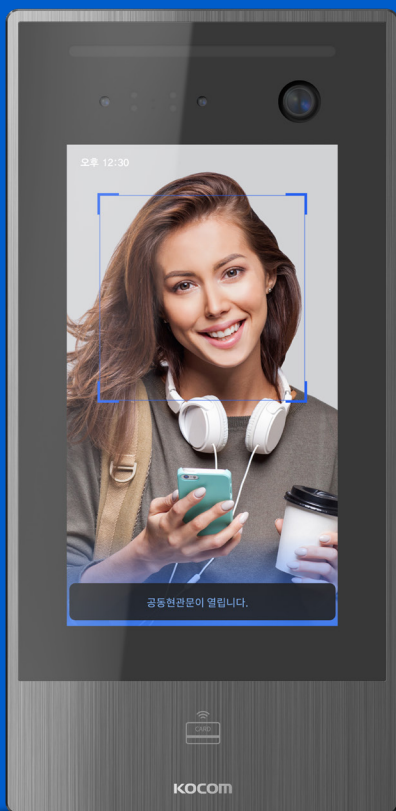

## Caution

### Cautions for set-up




-  · The law limits distributing the power lines to an authorized person from government. The work from an unauthorized person cause fire or electric shock.

- Fix the product on the wall safely according to the installation guideline to prevent any damage or injury.
- The work of distributing wires needs skills and experiences. So please, for assistance, contact your dealer or call service center.
- The communication lines should be built in being distant from the power source. This may result in the risk of fire, electric shock and communication disorder.
-  · Setting the communication lines in a high humid place such as outside without any protection from rain causes the communication disorder.

- Do not disassemble this unit as will as this device is composed by precision parts.
- Install the unit by following the set-up instructions of Kocom.
- Do not touch or insert any foreign substances, for example, sticker, magnetic, opener and the like.
- Make U-type at the end of wires as the rain can effect on the system by following the wires during the rainy season.

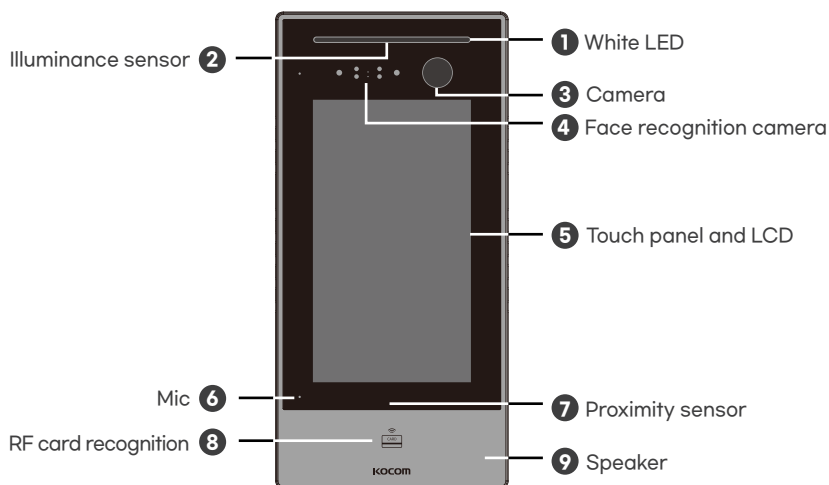
### ► Cautions

- In some cases there is occurrence of product destruction, malfunction, noise mixing and picture quality deterioration due to mixing of other tool's induced. voltage or thunder with communication wiring of monitor/camera, monitor/extended monitor.  
Do not wire with power line such as outdoor wiring or AC power, or phones and other tools.
- You cannot use it if you incorrectly wire the AC voltage between monitor/camera, monitor/extended monitor.  
Call the store or agency where you purchased this product and consult to solve the problem.  
Beware that unfixable damage might be caused due to authorizing AC voltage on communication wiring of monitor/camera, monitor/extended monitor.
- Do not ever disjoint this product. It may cause electrocution accident when touching high-voltage circuit inside this product.
- Outside power authorizing this product must be confirmed of product description and use rated voltage.  
Beware that if higher voltage is authorized, unfixable damage might be caused due to product destruction.
- Power must be connected to domestic voltage (product rated voltage) consent or interior wiring.  
If connected to other motive power or inverter-type power, product destruction, noise mixing, and picture distortion may occur.
- Do not drop this product. Glass is used for monitor and might break, or cause other circuit inferiority.  
In such case, immediately turn down the power switch, and call to consult agency or store in which this product was purchased.

- If installed near transmission antenna such as broadcasting station, electric wave may mix and cause picture distortion or voice mixing.

- As in the picture, it prevents temperature difference of camera (outside) and monitor (inside), and removes dew condensation caused by humidity of camera window.
- Camera must be installed when wall cement is completely dry.
- When product is installed in winter below -5°C, wait for approximately 2 hours to connect.  
Dew formation in monitor and camera due to temperature difference inside and outside may cause product defect.
- Avoid installing monitor and camera in place directly exposed to heat or where gas noxiousness is highly occurring.

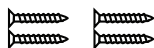

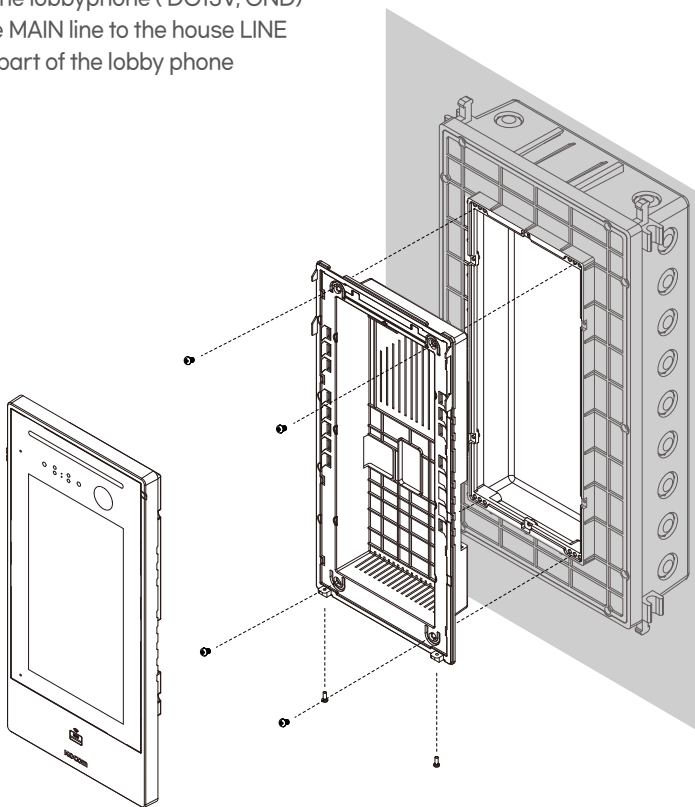

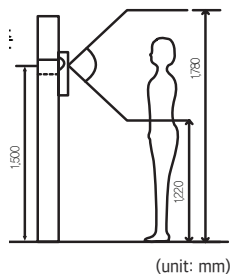
- Install the power supply 13V in the flush box
- Connect the power supply output to POWER IN terminal of the lobbyphone ( DC13V, GND)
- Connect the MAIN line to the house LINE connection part of the lobby phone



## Standard height for lobby phone installation

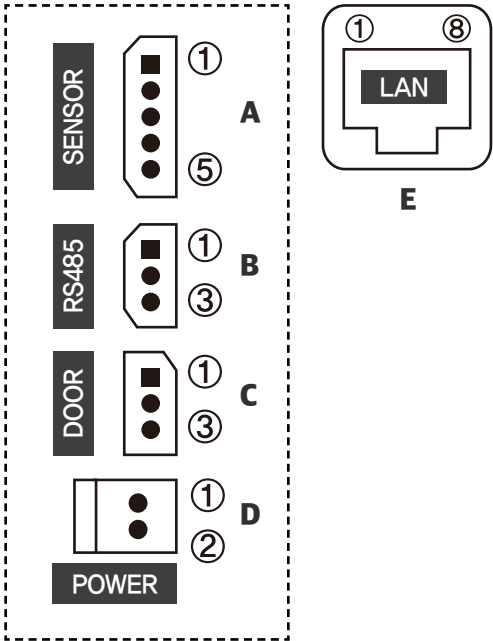
### Lobby phone camera based on lens center

The standard height of the lobby phone is 1,450 ~ 1,500 from the bottom based on the bottom of the lobby phone flush box. If the height of the lobby phone is out of the range of 1,250mm to 1,550mm, it is impossible to adjust the desired image only by adjusting the angle of the lens, so be careful of height when installing the lobby phone

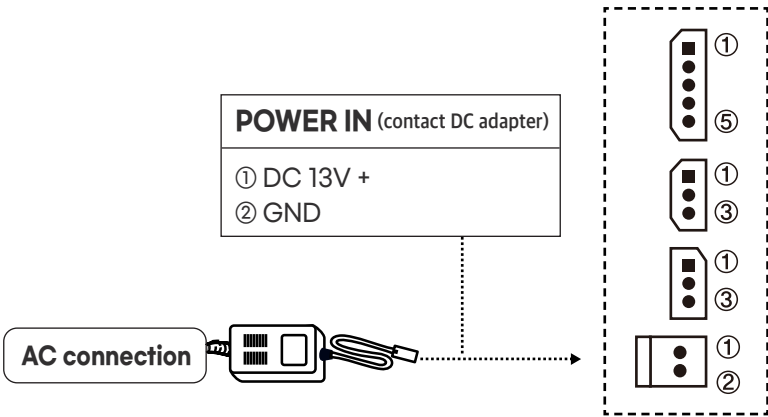

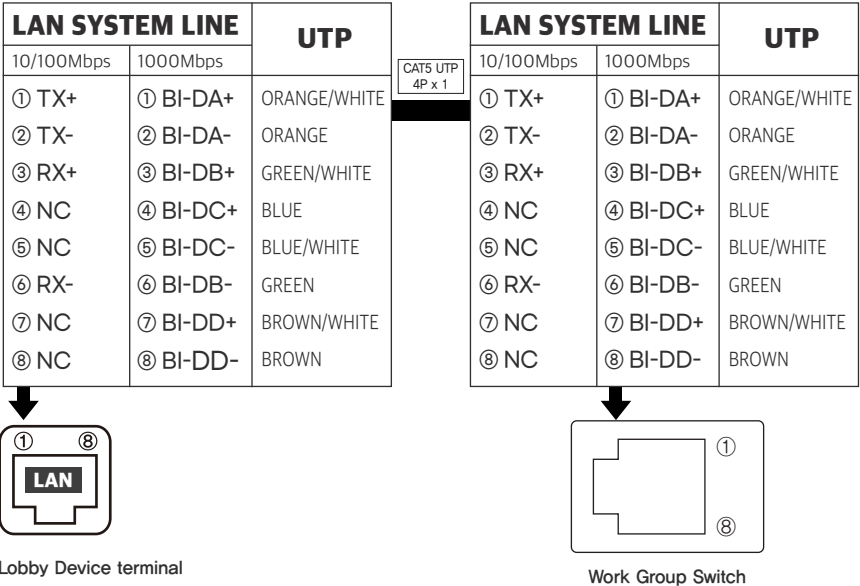
## 1) POWER IN

- The power input port is connected to the exclusive DC 13V adaptor.
- The power input port is connected with the exclusive DC connection wire.



## 2) LAN SYSTEM LINE connection

- The LAN main wiring port is connected to the work group switch within the apartment complex.
- The LAN main wiring port is connected with an RJ plug.
- The LAN main wiring port and work group switch can be connected at the length up to 100 meters with CAT5 UTP.



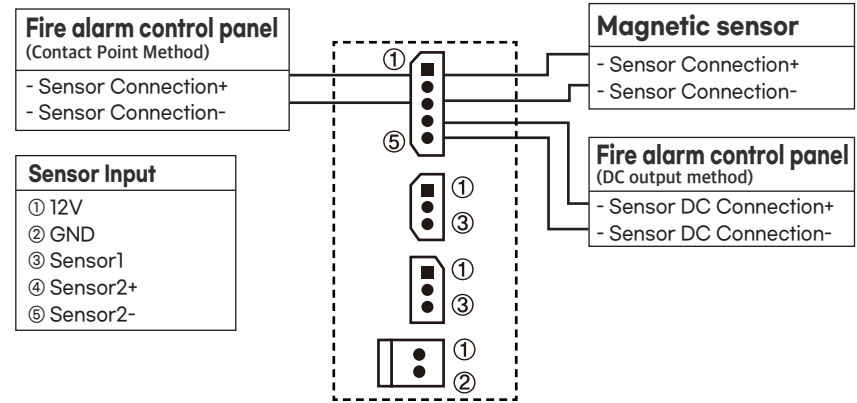

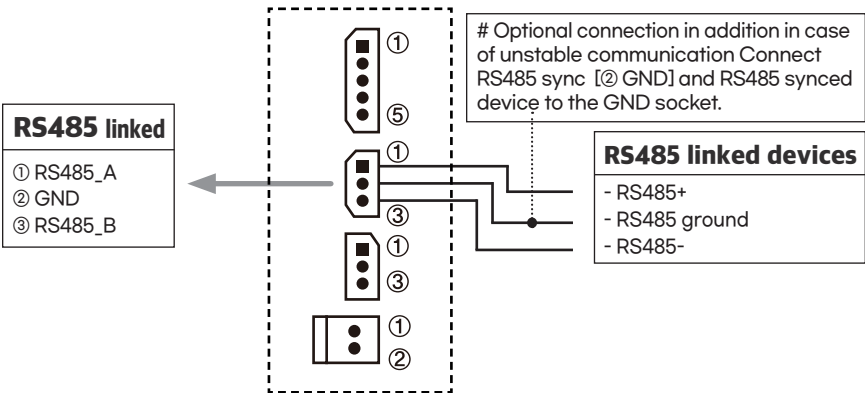
## 3) Sensor Connection

- The sensor port is the socket that connects the sensor devices.
- The device is connected to the sensor port with a separate UTP cable.
- Only 2 sensor devices can be connected to the sensor port.
- ①12V, ②GND can be used to provide power to the sensor device.
- For magnetic sensor connection, use ①12V, ③sensor 1.
- For contact point-type receiver connection, use ①12V, ③sensor 1.
- For DC-type fire receiver connection, use ④sensor 2+, ⑤sensor 2-.
- The sensor port and sensor device can be connected at a length of up to 10 meters with UTP.



## 4) RS485 Linked device connection

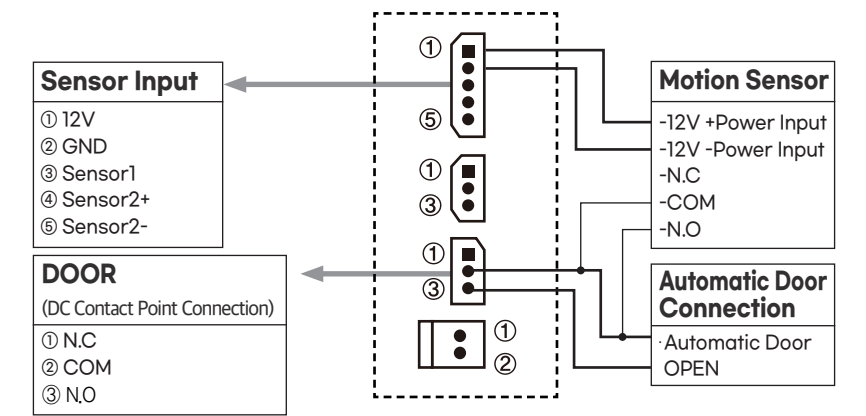
- RS485 sync is the connection socket for RS 485 synced device.
- Connect the DATA\_A or + socket with the ① RS485\_A socket and RS485 synced device.
- Connect the DATA\_B or - socket with the ③ RS485\_B socket and RS485 synced device.
- If the communication is unstable, connect the GND socket to the ② GND and RS485 synced device.
- The RS485 sync port and RS485 synced device can be connected at a length of up to 10 meters with CAT5 UTP.

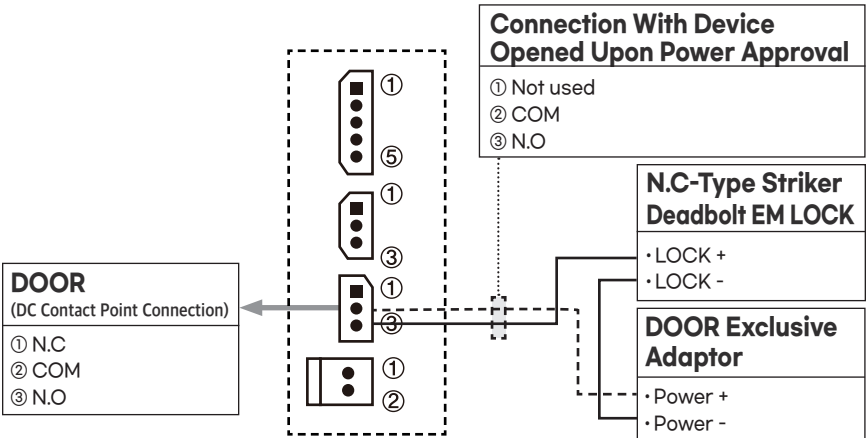
## 5) Automatic Door Connection

- The door device is connected to the door port with a separate UTP cable.
- Only 1 door device can be connected to the door port.
- The N.O-type automatic door connects the ②contact point COM with ③contact point N.O
- The N.C-type automatic door connects the ②contact point COM with ①contact point N.C
- The door port and door device can be connected at a length of up to 5 meters with CAT5 UTP



## 6) DOOR (Power Approval Type Door Device)

- The door port is the socket that connects the door device. ■ The door port is connected to the door device with the exclusive UTP cable. ■ Only 1 door device can be connected to the door port.
- When connecting the power approval type to the door device (striker, deadbolt, EMLOCK), an exclusive adaptor is used for the door device. (See figure below for wiring connection.) ■ The door device opened upon power approval connects ②contact point COM and ③contact point N.O. ■ The door device closed upon the power approval connects ②contact point COM and ① contact point N.C. ■ The door device can be connected up to 5 meters with UTP CAT5.

- The face recognition may take a long time or fail if you do not follow the instruction on display.
- Do not wear sunglasses, hats, or eyepatches.
- Be careful not to make two faces appear on the same screen. - Register one at a time.
- We recommend those who wear glasses to register both their faces with glasses on and off.
- Be careful not to cover your forehead, eyes, eyebrows, and ears.
- If you have changed your hairstyle, please register again.
